"All guests are completely anonymous and crew are trained in the highest levels of privacy and service," explains Baynes. The yacht is also equipped with high level security cameras and alarms and the crew are specially trained. There are extra sleeping quarters for body guards if a client wishes to bring a security detail. Plus, being out on the water makes it very difficult to approach the yacht without alerting the crew." 
